

accessible things to do in Armidale

- 1. Natural Wonders, Waterfalls and Gorges. Dangars Gorge, Wollomombi Gorge, Point Lookout and Ebor Falls provide viewing platforms and short 500m wheelchair-friendly tracks that are easily accessible from the carpark area
- **2. Self-Guided Heritage Drive**: View private residences, schools, the railway station, old Catholic Orphanage, *Booloominbah* (55-room mansion at University of New England), impressive public buildings, monuments and parklands approximately 25km.
- **3. New England Regional Art Museum:** NERAM (open 10.00am-4.00pm Tuesday-Sunday) is home to over 3,500 works of art including the Howard Hinton and Coventry Collections.
- **4. Aboriginal Cultural Centre and Keeping Place:** (open 9.00am-4.00pm Monday–Friday and 10.00am-2.00pm Saturday). Experience the diversity of Australian Aboriginal art and culture.
- **5. Saumarez Homestead:** A National Trust property (gardens and farm buildings open 10.00am-4.00pm Sunday comprising an imposing house set in extensive English-style gardens and a complex of 12 farm buildings. Tour of the homestead is available on Sunday ONLY at 10.30am with wheelchair access to the downstairs area of the homestead.
- **6. Museums:** The Museum of Antiquities and the Natural History Museum located at the University of New England house excellent collections of historical interest.
- **7. Petersons Winery:** Cool climate award-winning wines, heritage-listed gardens, cellar door and guesthouse.
- **8. Dumaresq Creek Biodiversity Track:** Explore the Dumaresq Creek track and discover some of the New England's amazing biodiversity.
- **9. Self-guided Heritage Walk** (in conjunction with Armidale Mobility Map). Explore the heritage buildings, cathedrals, churches and the city of Armidale.

The Armidale Visitor Information Centre has a detailed list of accessible accommodation in Armidale including motels, bed & breakfasts, self contained and guesthouse accommodation.
